Our grassroots educational organization consists of a diverse group of women leaders committed to bringing together young girls and women to learn from and about each other. Today, the organization effectively offers meaningful, women-focused educational events, intergenerational leadership development, dialogue and coaching sessions, as well as mentoring and peer-networking services that prove to be beneficial in diversity and positive social change.

OUR GOALS

Our work is centered on goals designed to:

- Collaborate with area women's organizations to build a strong community of diversity and inclusion.
- Facilitate intergenerational leadership workshops.
- Provide a platform where women and young girls can find their voice and share their stories.
- Mentor women and youth in need of professional and personal development.
- Develop a connecting hub for women's focus groups and organizations.

PROGRAMS

Educational Initiatives offers community-based knowledge and information about local women including a Women Success Series. Discussions center on how local women can help support each other, celebrate success and make true progress. To date, featured programs have included Women in the Arts, Women in Uniform, Women in Sports, Women in Construction and WOT members' stories success. A panel discussion centering on different cultures and ethnicity, women experiences in day-to-day living and work, and an Equal Pay Awareness event presentation.

Women's Connection provides mentoring and guidance for women of all ages. This program encourages women in transition to embrace change, improve performance, raise awareness, and assist in personal and professional development. Our 419 Wine & Dine occurs monthly and takes place on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. We also offer a Women's Connection program for our Young Women and Girls of Toledo. Women in Action is a social and peer-networking team that collaborates with other women through meaningful and fun events designed to enlighten, engage and empower women. Our featured event was 419 Flavors which focused on ethnic foods with simple preparations and easy to follow recipes. In summer 2016, we launched our new **Women Sailing Program** with an objective to help women develop skills and strength for leadership, seamanship, Team Unity and the useful art of sailing. This program successfully recruited 24 women to play an integral part in establishing the sailing crew.
